•	I/we acknowledge that I/we have read the service's Fees Policy (available on the Tarralla Kindergarten website), which outlines the procedure for payment of fees.
•	I/we acknowledge that three-year-old kindergarten for 2022 is only funded for 5 hours per week by the state government, with the balance of hours to be paid in fees by parents/guardians. (The only exception is where a child is eligible for the Early Start Kindergarten fee subsidy – see below).
•	I/we understand that I/we am/are entitled to obtain the Kindergarten Fee Subsidy if I/we meet one of the criteria outlined in the Fees Policy. If my/our eligibility lapses, then I/we understand that full payment of fees is required from the beginning of the following term.
•	I/we agree to pay fees by the due date on the invoice.
•	I/we acknowledge that if fees are not paid by the due date, the Committee of Management will implement the late payment of fees procedures, as outlined in the <i>Fees Policy</i> which could result in the withdrawal of my/our child's place at the service.
•	I/we understand that term fees are non-refundable.
•	I/we understand that children are unable to commence attendance of the program until they have turned 3, but that in order to reserve a place, the admin fee must be paid in full as per the 3yo Fees Schedule
•	I/we agree that if my/our financial circumstances change and I/we am/are unable to pay as agreed, I/we will immediately notify the Fees Officer to discuss alternative payment options.
